- **Tuesday, October 9: Last day to register to vote in the General Election** (Name and address changes are accepted after the deadline.)
- October 10: Early ballots are mailed out
- **October 10 - November 2: Early Voting Sites are open**
- October 26: Last day to request a Ballot by Mail
- **Tuesday, November 6: General Election Day**
