National Voter Registration Day (NVRD) is a national holiday celebrating our democracy. It was first observed in 2012 and has been growing in popularity every year since. Held on the fourth Tuesday of September, NVRD will be observed on Tuesday, September 25th this year. It has been endorsed by the National Association of Secretaries of State and is further supported by the National Association of State Election Directors.

The League of Women Voters of Greater Tucson (LWVGT), the City of Tucson and Pima County encourage individuals to register to vote, and to help their family, friends and neighbors to do so during the month of September and through October 9<sup>th</sup>, the last day to register and be eligible to vote in the November 6, 2018 mid-term election.

Our three entities also encourage local media and social media outlets to educate Southern Arizonans about how to register, sign up for election reminders, check their registration online, get vote by mail ballots, learn about early voting, and how to access the Pima County Recorder's Office to get the most up to date voter registration and election information.
