Encouraging citizen participation in the governmental process is a key role of the League of Women Voters of Greater Tucson (LWVGT). However, seeking current contact details for elected officials can be a challenge given the varied timing of elections for school boards, cities, county, state, national and tribal governments.

LWVGT has a solution, it's 2019 "Citizen's Directory of Elected Officials" for members of the Southern Arizona community. It contains information for every elected official in Pima County and those who represent Pima County in Phoenix and Washington D.C. For over 16 years, it has been a valued resource for anyone who desires to speak out and/or remain up to speed with what our elected officials are doing. It contains 16 pages of the most current elected officials contact details.

The publication is free and available at all Tucson-Pima County Public Libraries. It can also be viewed and downloaded on the league website: lwgvt.org.

"This is one of several projects of the League of Women Voters of Greater Tucson to help citizens be more informed and take a more active role in their government and in voting," shared LWVGT President, Judy Wood. "We are non-partisan and never support a given party or candidate, but we urge every eligible person to register to vote and cast their ballot."
