**New Studies:** This is also the time to look at potential issues for new studies. Is there a local or national issue that is timely? Can it be solved by government action? Does it meet League principles? Can the League make a difference? Does it provide opportunities for League action? Will it raise our visibility and credibility? Are other groups interested?

After you have identified an issue for a new local or national study, write it concisely on the form, being specific but flexible. Next, write a Scope for the study to describe the limits of the study and outline the subject area.
